Every day, over 21,000 people breathe in dioxin and other pollutants from Kodak's hazardous waste incinerators. Every year, Kodak burns over 70 million pounds of cancer-causing chemicals, exposing children at over 20 schools within a 3 mile radius of Kodak Park.

Children are highly vulnerable to toxic chemicals. Proportionately they breathe in more air, eat more food and drink more water than adults.

Unfortunately, Kodak's dangerous dioxin releases may be taking a profound toll on the people of Rochester, NY. In just one year, 33 cases of childhood

brain and spinal cord cancer were found in a five mile radius around Kodak. Women living near Kodak Park for more than 20 years were found to have approximately a 96% greater risk of developing pancreatic cancer. As a multi-national corporation with sales exceeding \$13 billion, Kodak needs to make an investment in our children's health and Rochester's future by phasing out their toxic incinerators.
